Key Terms

The key terms listed below are for information purposes. In the event of any conflict between these key terms and the full terms and conditions, the full terms and conditions will apply.

- (A) You must be 16 years of age or older to purchase a Raffle ticket or receive a prize.
- (B) Each Raffle Ticket will be sold for £1.
- (C) Applications for RT Rugby Raffle 2021 tickets received after 23:59 on Monday 29th November 2021 will not be entered into the RT Rugby Raffle 2021 and the payment for such Raffle tickets will be treated as a donation to Rosie's Trust.
- (D) Employees of Rosie's Trust are not allowed entry to the RT Rugby Raffle 2021
- (E) Friends and family of Rosie's Trust staff can enter the RT Rugby Raffle 2021.
- (F) The Prizes for the Raffle are John Cooney's Rugby boots, Lions polo signed by Rory Best and Signed Ulster Rugby jersey & ball.

RT Rugby Raffle 2021 Entry Conditions

1. To be eligible to purchase a RT Rugby Raffle ticket, a person must:
 - a) be 16 years of age or over;
 - b) located in Northern Ireland or Great Britain
 - c) not be an employee of Rosie's Trust and d) comply with these terms and conditions.
2. A Raffle ticket will be entered into the RT Rugby Raffle 2021 if:
 - a) an application for a Raffle ticket is received by Rosie's Trust before

the closing date (23:59 Monday 29th November 2021)

b) payment for an application is received by Rosie's Trust before the same closing date.

3. Each Raffle ticket will be sold for £1.

4. By purchasing a Raffle ticket, you agree to provide a minimum of your surname, postcode and telephone number. Your personal data will be used in order to contact you if you have won a prize and to contact you, consent allowing, about future fundraising, our services, or both. 8. Any payment for Raffle tickets received after the Closing Date will be treated as a donation to Rosie's Trust.

9. The winners will be drawn online on Wednesday 1st December 2021. The draw date is subject to change and is at Rosie's Trust's discretion.

10. The winning raffle tickets will be drawn randomly using a random number generator.

11. The result of the Draw is final.
